This complete refurbishment of a Victorian terraced house includes a new studio, a feature steam-bent staircase, and a luxe, layered interior scheme. The client, design and architecture PR Katherine Sandford-Anderson. asked Simon Gill Architects for an extension to provide a new kitchen, dining and sitting area, utility and cloakroom, with a new stair to the ground floor. She also asked for a family room and office at the end of the garden. A high spec, innovative outlook and stylish end result were top priorities, reflecting the client's profession.
